If a major part needs to be replaced, it could cost more than the price, so the TV would cost more to repair than to replace. Some repair shops have a minimum charge of \$25 just to look at a crashed computer. Are they making millions of dollars? No. A recent survey found that more and more repair shops are closing because they cannot afford to stay in business. In 1992 there were more than 20,000 repair shops in the United States; by 2004, there were fewer than 9000. But price is not the only reason. According to a repair shop owner, customer psychology has changed. 'It is a disposable society.....people want the newest and the hottest.' the only way to change it is to make it expensive to throw things away, but we do not do that until the mountains of rubbish are so high we can't breathe.

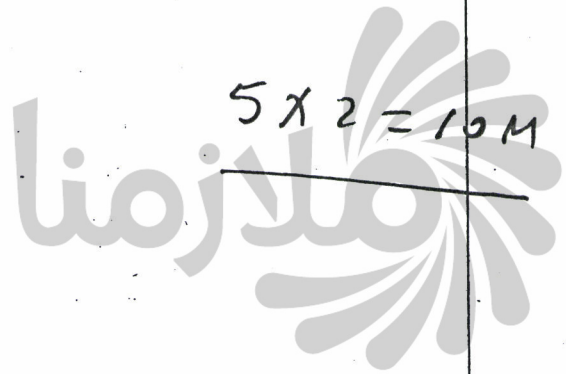
